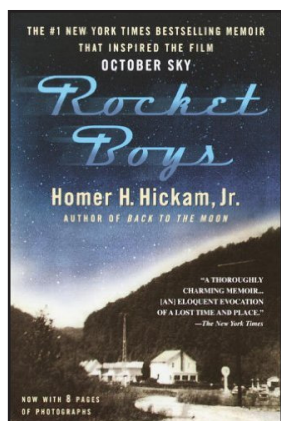
## Join in the Conversation!

Registration for this club is limited.

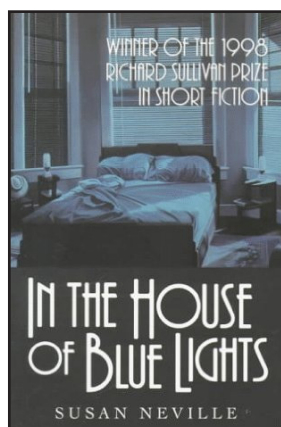
